Tax credit with your payment receipt


The tutoring fees paid to the L.M.S. Center enable to obtain a tax credit with your payment receipt. In fact, the minister of revenue Gail Shea has recently announced the government has deployed a federal budget for a new non-reimbursable tax credit on child artistic activities.

“This tax credit helps families (...) register their children in programs that contribute to their love for art but also to the development of their intellectual and interpersonal competencies” Minister Shea added.

In addition to the programs which are covered by tax credit for the physical condition of children, parents can now reduce their year-end tax with expenses related to the domain of music, the performing arts, language learning, studying a culture, **tutoring** and more.
